What is the Redrow Degree?

At its core the three-year Construction Management in Housebuilding degree BSc was developed by Redrow in partnership with Liverpool John Moores University and Coleg Cambria. The degree is designed to support further development within your current role and expand your knowledge in all areas of construction and management. It's further evidence of how we value our people and demonstrates the commitment to our employees and improving the construction industry as a whole.

Who is the degree for?

The Redrow degree is open to our employees within Redrow, including Site Managers, Assistant Site Managers, Sales Consultants, and Customer Care and Technical teams. In fact any colleague able to commit the time with the support of their line manager can opt in to undertaking the Redrow Degree!

How is the Degree structured?

The degree course will see students study six modules each year covering different areas of housebuilding, including quality, project management, health and safety, business skills and negotiations, through to aspects of law, mathematics and economics.

There will be six blocks of learning throughout each year consisting of one week each held at the Coleg Cambria campus in Wrexham in our own dedicated Redrow suite. With more direct access to lecturers and tutors, the smaller group size compared to a regular degree will facilitate your learning and allow you to have a more direct influence on the manner in which you learn.

You will work towards an assignments following each module working to a strict deadline; this will require good time management and commitment to complete within the time frame.

What are the benefits to me?

A degree education gives the opportunity to learn a wide variety of skills, analytical, research, time management, networking to name just a few.

The Construction Management in Housebuilding course syllabus allows colleagues from across the company to learn about every aspect of the modern housebuilding process – from land survey, design, construction to completion and sale and represents a fantastic opportunity to further knowledge of our business.

What accreditations are included as part of the degree?

As part of the Degree you will also gain a student membership to the Chartered Institute of Building (CIOB) leading to a full membership on completion of the degree.

How can I get on the degree programme?

You are eligible to undertake the degree if you have support from your line manager and authorisation and meet any of the following criteria:

- Have at least a level 3 qualification, NVQ, BTEC or A-levels
- 5 Years on site experience

It is important that you understand the level of commitment and work that will be asked of you once you begin your pathway on the degree. Redrow will support you however we can but the drive and commitment to undertake the degree can only come from you!
